## Project #1 - Highway Barn Emergency Generator

- It is expected that the cost of the project will require a public bid where a
  formal Front-End Contract will be required. A contract, technical
  specification(s) and a site plan will be required for a Construction
  Contract to be Advertised for Public Bid.
- Engineers Opinion of Probable Cost
  - General Conditions = \$5,000.00
  - Electrical Equipment = \$29,000.00
  - Conduit and Wire = \$15,000.00
  - Excavation/Sitework = \$8,500.00
  - Subtotal = \$57,500.00
  - $\circ$  Contractor OH&P (15%) = \$8,625.00
  - Construction Subtotal = \$66,125.00
  - Contingency (20%) = \$13,225.00
  - Construction Total = \$79,350.00
- Engineering
  - Design Documents = \$12,500.00
  - o Bidding = \$2,000.00
  - $\circ$  CA/CO = \$7,250.00
  - Engineering Total = \$21,750.00
- Total Project Cost = \$101,100.00
- Design Documents
  - Initial kick-off meeting to confirm location and size of generator.
     Work with Highway Superintendent on documenting desired equipment location and existing electrical usage at Highway Garage.



- Development of front-end contract documents in Engineers Joint Contract Documents Committee (EJCDC) Format to be developed for a Public Bid.
- Provide a site plan drawing for documenting proposed site work for Perspective Bidders to use in developing a construction cost estimate.
- o Provide a single line diagram documenting electrical improvements to incorporate 22 KW Generator and Automatic Transfer Switch.
- Engineer to publish Contract Documents with a Plan Room for access of documents by perspective bidders.

## - Bidding

- Engineer to address questions from contractors during public bid period. The public bid period for a job of this size will typically be 30 days.
- Engineer to call and solicit potential bidders.
- Engineer to attend Bid Opening and draft a recommendation letter to Town Board for award to apparent low bidder.

## - Construction Administration (CA)

- Engineer will work with apparent low bidder on receiving all necessary bonds/insurances prior to issuing a Notice of Award.
   Notice of Awards will be coordinated with the Owner for execution of Agreement and Notice to Proceeds executed with Contractor.
- Engineers will receive the submittals for equipment/materials on the project and will review/approve prior to incorporation into the project. The owner will be provided with a copy of the approved documents.
- Engineers will provide final closeout paperwork including operational and maintenance manuals.
- Total Cost of Services = \$5,120.00 (Lump Sum)

## - Construction Observation (CO)

- Perform four (4) 4-hour site visits to perform spot inspection services for work completed. One (1) visit will be dedicated to a walkthrough for closeout purposes and developing a punchlist.
- o 16 hours @ \$105/hour = \$1,680.00
- Travel 150 miles @ \$0.67/mile x 4 trips = \$450.00
- Total Observation Cost = \$2,130 (hourly, NTE)
